The award-winning Ring of Steel sponsors their fifth year of summer stunt camps with great new ideas and new stunts! Jedi, pirates, musketeers, knights - your children will get to play them all while under the supervision of staff who have trained professional stunt performers for over 30 years. No special skills are required and as this is non-competitive, lightly athletic play, both genders will have a marvelous time!
